
**DEFENDANT'S UNOPPOSED MOTION FOR REMOTE HEARING AND
APPEARANCE**

Defendant Timothy Busfield, through undersigned counsel, respectfully moves this Court to amend the Notice of Hearing issued for the in person hearing currently scheduled for March 10, 2026 at 8:30am. As grounds, Defendant states:

1. On Feb 10, 2026, Defendant filed a waiver of arraignment in this matter and entered a not guilty plea.
2. On February 11, 2026, the Court accepted the waiver of arraignment and set an in person scheduling conference for March 10, 2026.
3. On February 18, 2026, Defendant filed and the Court accepted Defendant's waiver of appearance at all pretrial proceedings.
4. Defense counsel Christopher Dodd has been unexpectedly required to leave the state due to a family emergency and is unavailable to appear in person at the March 10 hearing.
5. Defense counsel Amber Fayerberg is currently out of state but is available to proceed as scheduled and can appear remotely.
6. Undersigned counsel has conferred with counsel for the State. The State does not oppose this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Defendant respectfully requests that the Court amend the Notice of Hearing to permit the March 10, 2026 scheduling conference to proceed remotely and allow defense counsel to appear via Google Meet or another similar platform designated by the Court.


